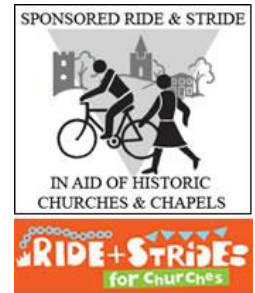
Ride and Stride 2021
